


# **3D Printing Guide**

#### **How to Print**


 Prepare your file. Save your design as an .STL file, either by creating it yourself with a 3D modeling software like TinkerCAD, or downloading one from a website like Thingiverse, Pinshape, Printables, and GrabCAD.



- 2. **Submit your file.** Bring it on a USB drive to the Adult Information Desk at the FCL Farmington Hills location (32737 W. 12 Mile Rd.) or email it to <a href="mailto:contact@farmlib.org">contact@farmlib.org</a>.
- 3. **Staff review.** A staff member will check if your design can be printed and provide a cost estimate based on print time and filament use. Jobs must fit within **10" wide x 6" tall x 6.7" deep**, take **12 hours or less**, and cost **at least \$1.**00 (see cost chart at the end of this document).



4. **Confirm details.** Choose a filament color (red, green, blue, orange, white, black, gray, or translucent) and provide your contact information.



5. **Pick up your print.** Staff will notify you when it's ready. Collect it at the Information Desk and pay at pickup.



### **FAQs**

What printer does the Library use? The Dremel DigiLab 3D45 (2017 model).

**What file types can be printed?** .STL files are recommended (stereolithography format).

**What material is used?** PLA filament (a recyclable polyester made from renewable materials like corn starch and sugarcane).

**Can I print in multiple colors?** No, each job must be a single color. Available colors: red, green, blue, orange, white, black, gray, or translucent.

**How large can a print be?** Maximum size is 10" wide x 6" tall x 6.7" deep.

When do I pay? At pickup.

#### How much does it cost?

- Material: \$0.05 per gram (minimum \$1.00).
- **Time:** \$0.25 per additional half-hour after the first hour, up to 12 hours (see table below).
- **Example:** A 50-gram print costs \$2.50, plus any time charges.
